In accordance with Title 2, Sec. 2-1-3 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Verona and Wis. Stats. § 7.51, 7.52 and 7.53(m), and pursuant to the order of the United States District Court Judge William M. Conley dated April 2, 2020, the City of Verona Local Board of Canvassers and the City of Verona Municipal Board of Canvassers will convene on the date and time indicated above to canvass the April 7, 2020 Presidential Preference and Spring Election absentee ballots and conduct the Municipal canvass if required.

The Local Board of Canvassers will meet first at 2:30 p.m. It is expected that the Local Board of Canvassers' meeting will last approximately 90 minutes. Immediately following the adjournment of the Local Board of Canvassers meeting, the Municipal Board of Canvassers will meet.

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Verona Local Board of Canvassers and the Municipal Board of Canvassers will hold their meetings as virtual meetings. The Local Board of Canvassers and the Municipal Board of Canvassers will meet in person at City Hall, 111 Lincoln Street, but the meeting will not be open to the public due to COVID-19.
